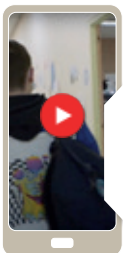
- ▶ **School grades:** 10 to 12 (Lycée)

Languages taught at school

1st foreign language: English; 2nd foreign language: German or Spanish; 3rd language: Arabic or Japanese. Latin is also offered as an option.

Options offered to students are subject to availability upon arrival. Lessons are at school or in clubs depending on the activity. Registration may be charged to the student for activities outside school and acceptance is at the discretion of the club.

FAQ

How many students per room?

Double or individual rooms. Rooms are same-sex.

Where are the dorms located?

Grade 10: 9 minutes walking distance from the school («site Collégiale» to «site Université»)

Grades 11 and 12: within the premises («site Université»)

Are outings allowed?

On Wednesday afternoons and 2 evenings per week if attending a club activity (11 pm curfew).

What about laundry?

Students can do their laundry on the weekend while at their host family. If needed, there are also washing machines at the school.

When are meals?

Breakfast: from 7:30 am to 8 am
Lunch: from 11:30 am to 1:15 pm, depending on timetable
Dinner: 7 pm

Are there set times to do homework?

From 6 pm to 7 pm (compulsory) and optional after dinner

What about school holidays?

5-day boarders stay with a host family with full board (included in the program fee)
